Education Council

1. Continue to serve as a resource for AAPA staff on CME issues, including CME approval and definitions of Category 1 and 2.
2. Maintain awareness of items of mutual interest with ARC-PA, NCCPA, APPAP, and PAEA.
3. Continue to provide information on professional competence for dissemination to PAs.
4. Continue to work to integrate objectives on PA competencies into AAPA's CME objectives.
5. Monitor evolving trends regarding PA educational degrees and credentials and make policy recommendations as needed.
6. Work in collaboration with PAEA to monitor the development of recommendations or policy regarding the internationalization of the U.S. physician assistant education curriculum
7. Serve as a resource to CEPC to integrate competencies into the conference program.
8. Monitor the potential impact that increased medical school enrollment and increased residency positions may have on PA training and clinical rotations.
