Misled/confused about the vaccine	Skeptical/concerned about the vaccine



How to say it...

Tailor your message– perceptions of vaccines vary

Respect concerns or skepticismavoid judgment Recognize the rigorevery study, every phase, and every trial was reviewed by the FDA and a safety board

Explain the benefits of getting a vaccine, not just the consequences of not getting one

Focus on the people behind the vaccine rather than the process (e.g., scientists-not science)
