AAPA's bylaws (Article VI, Section 2) specify each chapter's apportionment is determined by the number of AAPA fellow members it has as of January 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. The minimum number of delegates any chapter has, regardless of size, is two (2). When the number of fellow members within a chapter's jurisdiction exceeds 220, it will be apportioned a third delegate. An additional delegate will be apportioned for every additional 300 members.

Student delegates are apportioned at a straight ratio of 1:850. Specialty organizations (SOs) and Caucuses each have one delegate per organization. The immediate past and current house officers are considered "delegates at large" and comprise the remainder of the HOD.

Please reference the attached chart for the number of delegates your organization has been apportioned for the House of Delegates in Nashville. The HOD will meet from Friday, May 15 through Sunday, May 17, 2020. These delegates take office July 1, 2019. Please remember, delegation size varies from year to year based on the guidance in Article VI.

Please submit (or resubmit if your election occurs later than July) the names of your organization's 2019-20 delegates no later than July 1, 2019. Timely identification of delegates allows AAPA to ensure the elected delegates for next year's House are kept informed of critical and pertinent information in the lead-up to Nashville's HOD.
