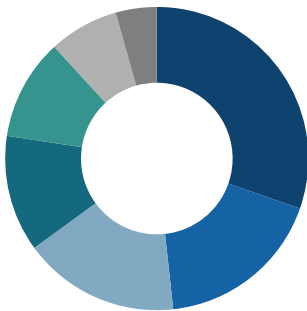

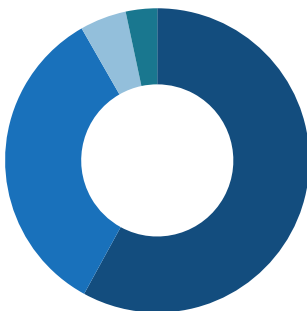
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Wisconsin



- 29.8% Surgical Subspecialties
- 17.6% All Other Specialties
- 16.4% Family Medicine
- 12.2% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 10.6% Emergency Medicine
- 7.3% Urgent Care
- 4.3% General Peds, General Internal Med

20.7% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Wisconsin



- 57.4% Physician Office or Clinic
- 33.4% Hospital Settings
- 4.9% Other Settings
- 3.3% Urgent Care Center

44.7% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Wisconsin

- ▣ 17.8% of PAs serve in rural areas
- ▣ A typical PA completes 50 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 48 hours per month
