


Percent of PAs by Specialty in West Virginia



- 23.5% Family Medicine
- 19.6% All Other Specialties
- 17.6% Surgical Subspecialties
- 13.7% Emergency Medicine
- 9.8% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 5.9% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 3.9% Urgent Care

33.3% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

Percent of PAs by Setting in West Virginia



- 45.1% Physician Office or clinic
- 41.2% Hospital Settings
- 11.8% Other Settings
- 2% Urgent Care Center

19.6% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In West Virginia

- 54% of PAs serve in rural areas
- A typical PA completes 55 patient visits per week
- A typical PA is on call 57 hours per month
