

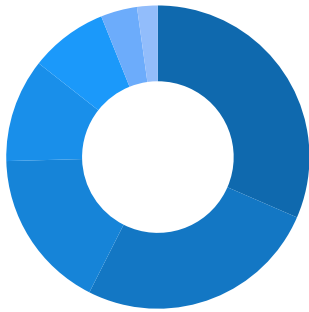

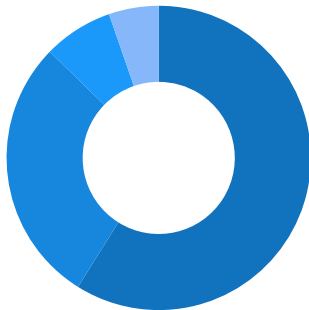
## Percent of PAs by Specialty in Utah



- 30% Surgical Subspecialties
- 24.7% All Other Specialties
- 16.3% Family Medicine
- 10.5% Urgent Care
- 7.9% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 3.7% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 2.1% Emergency Medicine

20% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

## Percent of PAs by Setting in Utah



- 58.9% Physician Office or clinic
- 28.4% Hospital Settings
- 7.4% Urgent Care Center
- 5.3% Other Settings

48.9% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

## In Utah

- ▣ 11.5% of PAs serve in rural areas
- ▣ A typical PA completes 56 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 60 hours per month
