


RHODE ISLAND PA PRACTICE PROFILE


Percent of PAs by Specialty in Rhode Island



- 23.7% Surgical Subspecialties
- 21.1% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 15.8% All Other Specialties
- 13.2% Family Medicine
- 7.9% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 5.3% Emergency Medicine
- 5.3% Urgent Care

21.1% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

Percent of PAs by Setting in Rhode Island



- 50% Physician Office or Clinic
- 31.6% Hospital Settings
- 10.5% Other Settings
- 7.9% Urgent Care Center

39.5% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Rhode Island

- A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- A typical PA is on call 24 hours per month
- 70% of Rhode Island PAs would choose their career over again
