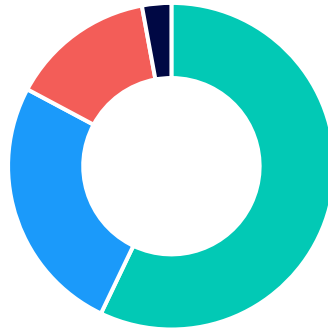

- ▶ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▶ A typical PA is on call 13.5 hours per month
