




Percent of PAs by Specialty in Pennsylvania

- 24.5% All Other Specialties
- 16.8% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 9% Family Medicine
- 7.2% Emergency Medicine
- 7.2% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 4.7% Urgent Care
