- 55.2% Physician office or clinic
- 32.0% Hospital settings
- 6.6% Urgent care center
- 6.2% Other settings

In North Carolina:

- ▶ 12.9% of North Carolina PAs serve in rural areas
- ▶ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▶ A typical PA is on call 38 hours per month
