




## Percent of PAs by Specialty in New York



- 27.7% Surgical Subspecialties
- 21.3% All Other Specialties
- 15.8% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 8.9% Emergency Medicine
- 8.5% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 7.6% Family Medicine
- 5.6% Urgent Care
