




Percent of PAs by Specialty in New Jersey



- 36.1% Surgical Subspecialties
- 13.4% All Other Specialties
- 11.8% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 8.8% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 8.8% Emergency Medicine
- 7.6% Family Medicine
- 6.7% Urgent Care

16.4% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

Percent of PAs by Setting in New Jersey



- 46.6% Physician Office or Clinic
- 40.8% Hospital Settings
- 7.1% Other Settings
- 5.5% Urgent Care Center

56.3% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In New Jersey

- ▣ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 50 hours per month
