
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Massachusetts



- 33.3% Surgical Subspecialties
- 18.5% All Other Specialties
- 13.9% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 8.8% Emergency Medicine
- 8.2% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 7.9% Urgent Care
- 5.5% Family Medicine

13.6% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

Percent of PAs by Setting in Massachusetts



- 47.3% Hospital Settings
- 40.3% Physician Office or Clinic
- 6.5% Urgent Care Center
- 6.1% Other Settings

31.5% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Massachusetts

- A typical PA completes 50 patient visits per week
- A typical PA is on call 24 hours per month
- 68.9% of Massachusetts PAs would choose their career over again
