Percent of PAs by Specialty in Massachusetts




Number of PAs in the United States:

178,700

- 37.1% Surgical subspecialties
- 20.8% All other specialties
- 12.9% Internal medicine subspecialties
- 9.7% Emergency medicine
- 7.2% General Peds, General IM
- 6.6% Familiiy medicine
- 4.1% Urgent care

Percent of PAs by Setting in Massachusetts



- 51.3% Hospital Settings
- 41.0% Physician office or clinic
- 4.8% Other settings
- 2.9% Urgent care center

In Massachusetts:

- A typical PA completes 50 patient visits per week
- A typical PA is on call 31 hours per month
- > 72.8% of Massachusetts PAs would choose their career over again
