




Percent of PAs by Specialty in Illinois



- 33.8% Surgical Subspecialties
- 24.4% All Other Specialties
- 12.5% Family Medicine
- 10.1% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 7.3% Emergency Medicine
- 4.7% Urgent Care
- 3.1% General Peds, General Internal Medicine

15.6% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

- 54.3% Physician Office or Clinic
- 36.9% Hospital Settings
- 4.7% Urgent Care Center
- 4.2% Other Settings

39% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Illinois

- ▣ A typical PA completes 55 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 46.5 hours per month
