

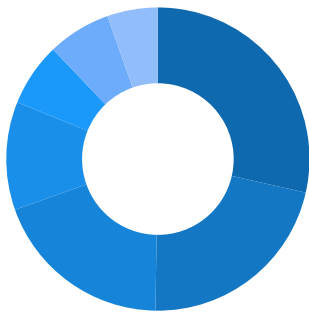

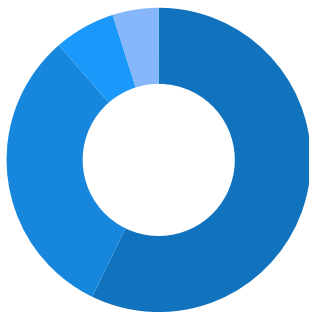
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Georgia



- 27.5% Surgical Subspecialties
- 20.9% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 18.6% All Other Specialties
- 11.1% Family Medicine
- 6.5% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 6.5% Urgent Care
- 5.2% Emergency Medicine

17.6% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

Percent of PAs by Setting in Georgia



- 57.2% Physician Office or Clinic
- 31.4% Hospital Settings
- 6.5% Urgent Care Center
- 4.9% Other Settings

54.2% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Georgia

- ▣ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 40 hours per month
- ▣ 69.3% of Georgia PAs would choose their career over again
