




Percent of PAs by Specialty in California



- 24.6% Surgical Subspecialties
- 22.3% All Other Specialties
- 16.4% Family Medicine
- 10.6% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 8.1% Urgent Care
- 6% Emergency Medicine
- 4.9% General Peds, General Internal Med

21.2% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

- 60.3% Physician Office or Clinic
- 24.4% Hospital Settings
- 8.2% Urgent Care Center
- 7.1% Other Settings

50.5% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In California

- ▣ A typical PA completes 69.5 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 24 hours per month
