Signed by Gov. Ron DeSantis on July 1, 2020, this new law modifies the composition of the PA Council (Council) to give PAs a majority in the regulation of the profession. This is one of the pillars of Optimal Team Practice (OTP).

Vermont Governor Signs Act Modernizing PA Practice

On July 1, Vermont Gov. Phil Scott signed <u>S.128</u>, an act related to PA licensure, into law. The legislation was the result of years of hard work by the PA Academy of Vermont (PAAV) and significantly improves PA practice in Vermont.
