



Hello,

We are so excited that you are joining us in person in Indianapolis! When you registered, you accepted our COVID Safety Policy. This means you are required to provide **proof of COVID-19 vaccination, or a negative COVID-19 test** (negative RT-PCR test or Rapid Antigen test\*) **taken within 72 hours of the start of AAPA 2022 in Indianapolis.** You are considered fully vaccinated:

- 2 weeks after your second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or
- 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.

*\*At-home, self-administered rapid antigen tests will not be accepted. Only rapid antigen test results provided by a third party will be accepted.*

If you intend to provide proof of a negative test, please wait until within the 72-hour window to upload your documentation.

*Please note that all safety measures are subject to change based on guidance from the CDC and local authorities at the time of the conference.*
