
Pump, then Tank: An Approach to Undifferentiated Shock

- Think about history, exam, ordering diagnostics
- Secure airway, obtained access, fix hypoxia, fix HR



- Ultrasound the heart
- Address effusion/tamponade
- Address RV or LV failure



- Consider volume status
- Consider fluid challenge

If indicated:

- Give volume resuscitation
- Give vasopressors

Reassess after each intervention
