## B's Blueprint for Pre-PA Success

### Choose Your Target Programs

- Consider program details, requirements, and culture
- Start broad, then narrow it down
- Attend info sessions and ask questions

### Meet Program Prerequisites

- Make a game plan to complete all course prerequisites
- Prepare for any standardized tests
- Find and build experience — be creative!
- Calculate your GPAs ahead of time

### Ace Your Personal Statement

- This is your golden ticket
- Your story should speak to your essence and passion for the profession

### Stay Involved

- Continue to volunteer and stay involved after you graduate or apply to PA school
- Get involved with AAPA and constituent organizations

### Find a Mentor

- Connect with PAs, professors, peers, colleagues, advisors, special interest groups, social media, student orgs, and Mentor Match
- Create an action plan and commit by following up

### Get Prepared

- Seek scholarships
- Practice time management
- Identify sources of support
- Follow programs and students on social media
