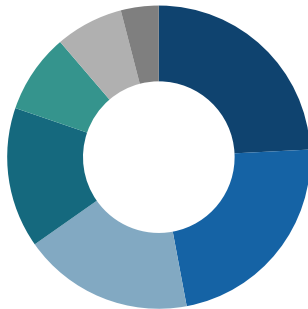

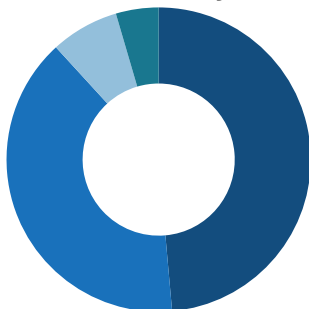
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Michigan



- 23.4% All Other Specialties
- 22.1% Surgical Subspecialties
- 17.6% Family Medicine
- 14.5% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 8.2% Emergency Medicine
- 7.0% Urgent Care
- 3.9% General Peds, General Internal Med

21.5% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Michigan



- 48.2% Physician Office or Clinic
- 39.3% Hospital Settings
- 7.2% Urgent Care Center
- 4.5% Other Settings

43.6% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Michigan

- 14.3% of PAs serve in rural areas
- A typical PA completes 64 patient visits per week
- A typical PA is on call 40 hours per month
