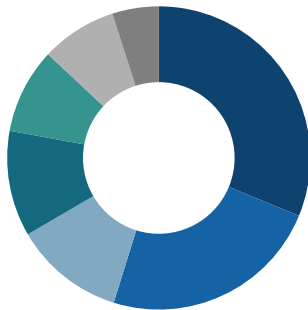

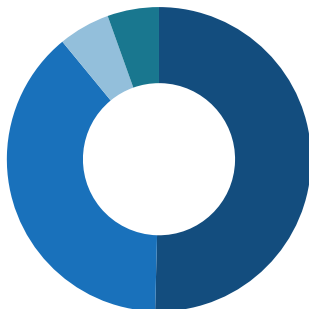
## Percent of PAs by Specialty in New York



- 30.2% Surgical Subspecialties
- 22.8% All Other Specialties
- 11.4% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 10.9% Emergency Medicine
- 8.8% Family Medicine
- 7.8% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 4.8% Urgent Care

16.6% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

## Percent of PAs by Setting in New York



- 49.7% Hospital Settings
- 38.1% Physician Office or Clinic
- 5.4% Other Settings
- 5.4% Urgent Care Center

31.7% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

## In New York

- ▣ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 25 hours per month
- ▣ 82% of New York PAs would choose their career over again
