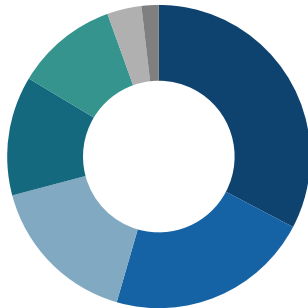

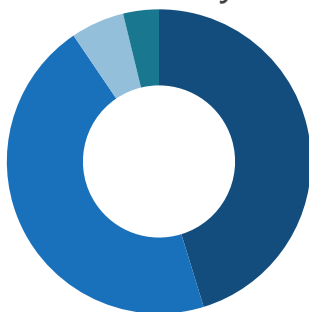
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Arkansas



- 32.1% All Other Specialties
- 21.4% Surgical Subspecialties
- 16.1% Emergency Medicine
- 12.5% Family Medicine
- 10.7% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 3.6% Urgent Care
- 1.8% General Peds, General IM

14.3% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Arkansas



- 42.9% Physician Office or Clinic
- 42.9% Hospital Settings
- 5.4% Urgent Care Center
- 3.6% Other Settings

46.4% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Arkansas

- 35.4% of PAs serve in rural areas
- A typical PA completes 80 patient visits per week
- 76.9% of Arkansas PAs would choose their career over again
