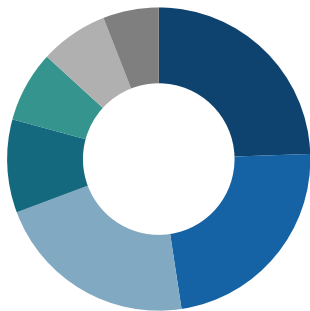

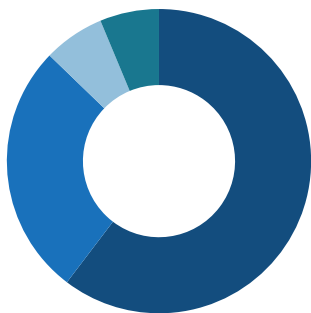
Percent of PAs by Specialty in California



- 23.9% Surgical Subspecialties
- 22.6% Family Medicine
- 21.2% All Other Specialties
- 9.7% Emergency Medicine
- 7.4% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 7.1% Urgent Care
- 5.8% General Peds, General Internal Med.

26 % of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in California



- 59.5% Physician Office or Clinic
- 26.5% Hospital Settings
- 6.4% Urgent Care Center
- 6.2% Other Settings

50.1% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In California

- A typical PA completes 75 patient visits per week
- A typical PA is on call 24 hours per month
- 83.2% of California PAs would choose their career over again
