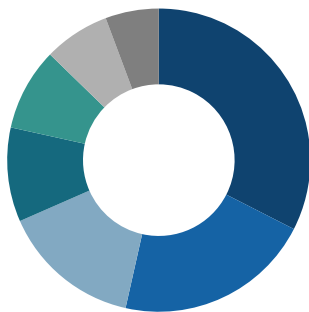

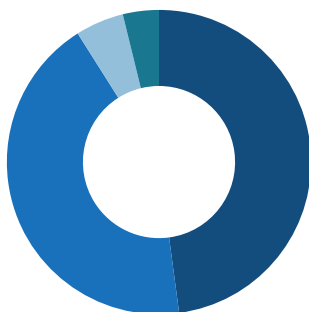
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Connecticut



- 31.4% Surgical Subspecialties
- 20.3% All Other Specialties
- 14.4% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 9.7% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 8.5% Emergency Medicine
- 6.8% Family Medicine
- 5.5% Urgent Care

16.5% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Connecticut



- 47.5% Hospital Settings
- 42.8% Physician Office or Clinic
- 5.1% Urgent Care Center
- 3.8% Other Settings

41.9% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Connecticut

- ▣ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 48 hours per month
- ▣ 81.6% of Connecticut PAs would choose their career over again
