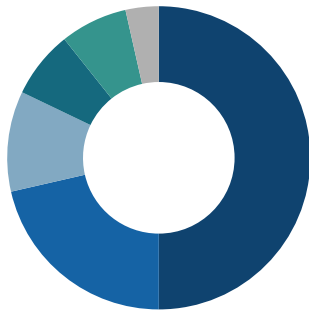

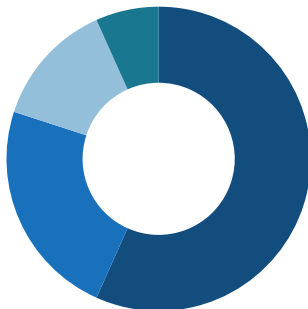
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Hawaii



- 46.7% Surgical Subspecialties
- 20.0% Family Medicine
- 10.0% Urgent Care
- 6.7% Emergency Medicine
- 6.7% All Other Specialties
- 3.3% General Peds, General Internal Med

23.3% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Hawaii



- 56.7% Physician Office or Clinic
- 23.3% Hospital Settings
- 13.3% Urgent Care Center
- 6.7% Other Settings

53.3% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Hawaii

- ▣ 17.2% of PAs serve in rural areas
- ▣ A typical PA completes 70 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 25 hours per month
