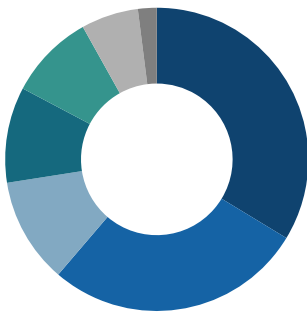

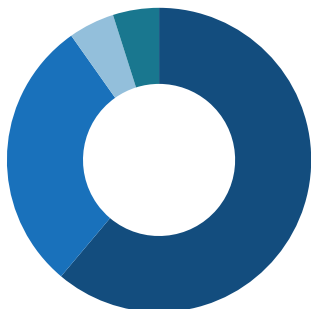
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Kansas



- 32.0% Surgical Subspecialties
- 26.2% Family Medicine
- 10.7% Emergency Medicine
- 9.7% All Other Specialties
- 8.7% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 5.8% Urgent Care
- 1.9% General Peds, General Internal Med

28.2% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Kansas



- 61.2% Physician Office or Clinic
- 29.1% Hospital Settings
- 4.9% Other Settings
- 4.9% Urgent Care Center

41.7% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Kansas

- ▣ 35.4% of PAs serve in rural areas
- ▣ A typical PA completes 70 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 100 hours per month
