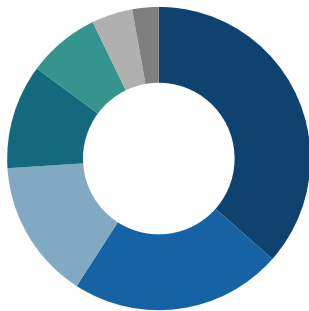

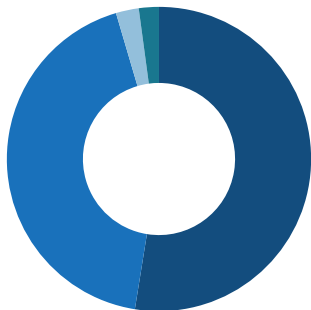
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Massachusetts



- 35.1% Surgical Subspecialties
- 21.7% All Other Specialties
- 14.3% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 10.7% Emergency Medicine
- 7.4% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 4.2% Family Medicine
- 2.7% Urgent Care

11.6% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Massachusetts



- 51.8% Hospital Settings
- 42.3% Physician Office or Clinic
- 2.4% Urgent Care Center
- 2.1% Other Settings

31.3% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Massachusetts

- ▣ A typical PA completes 50 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 22 hours per month
- ▣ 79.2% of Massachusetts PAs would choose their career over again
