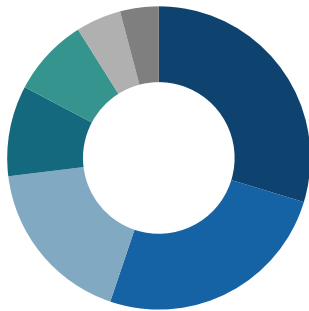

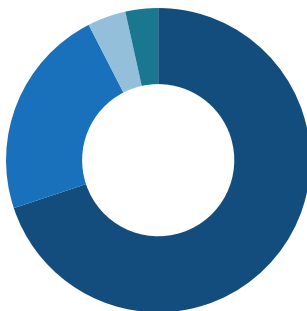
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Nebraska



- 28.9% Family Medicine
- 24.8% Surgical Subspecialties
- 17.4% All Other Specialties
- 9.4% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 8.1% Emergency Medicine
- 4.7% Urgent Care
- 4.0% General Peds, General Internal Med

32.9% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Nebraska



- 68.5% Physician Office or Clinic
- 22.5% Hospital Settings
- 4.0% Urgent Care Center
- 3.4% Other Settings

47% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Nebraska

- ▣ 30.8% of PAs serve in rural areas
- ▣ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 60 hours per month
