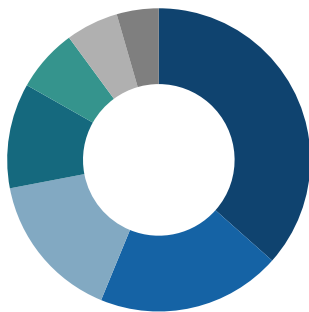

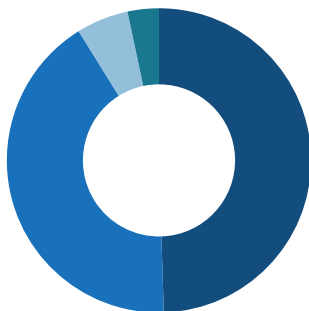
Percent of PAs by Specialty in New Jersey



- 35.9% Surgical Subspecialties
- 19.3% All Other Specialties
- 15.5% Emergency Medicine
- 11.0% Family Medicine
- 6.6% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 5.5% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 4.4% Urgent Care

16.6% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in New Jersey



- 49.2% Hospital Settings
- 41.4% Physician Office or Clinic
- 5.5% Other Settings
- 3.3% Urgent Care Center

57.5% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In New Jersey

- ❑ A typical PA completes 75 patient visits per week
- ❑ A typical PA is on call 48 hours per month
- ❑ 83.6% of New Jersey PAs would choose their career again
