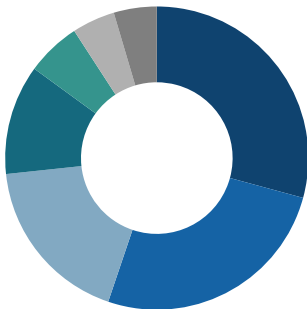

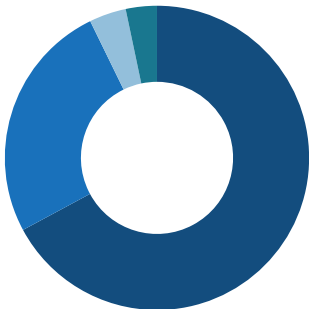
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Utah



- 28.7% Surgical Subspecialties
- 25.5% All Other Specialties
- 17.8% Family Medicine
- 11.5% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 5.7% Urgent Care
- 4.5% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 4.5% Emergency Medicine

22.3% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Utah



- 65.0% Physician Office or Clinic
- 24.8% Hospital Settings
- 3.8% Urgent Care Center
- 3.2% Other Settings

53.5% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Utah

- ▣ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 41 hours per month
- ▣ 85.3% of Utah PAs would choose their career over again
