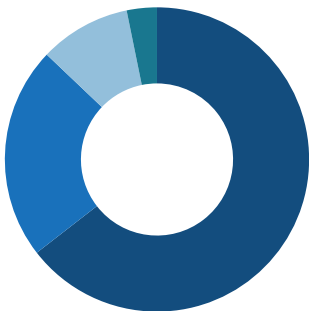
## Percent of PAs by Specialty in Vermont



- 29.0% Family Medicine
- 16.1% Emergency Medicine
- 16.1% Urgent Care
- 12.9% Surgical Subspecialties
- 9.7% All Other Specialties
- 6.5% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 6.5% Internal Medicine Subspecialties

35.5% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

## Percent of PAs by Setting in Vermont



- 64.5% Physician Office or Clinic
- 22.6% Hospital Settings
- 9.7% Urgent Care Center
- 3.2% Other Settings

19.4% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

## In Vermont

- ▣ 63.3% of PAs serve in rural areas
- ▣ A typical PA completes 55 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 30 hours per month
