**2019-01:** The Student Academy resolves to change the name of the “Assembly of Representatives Representative” to “Student Academy Representative” (SAR) - **PASSED**

**2019-02:** The Student Academy resolves to transition the “Diversity Representative” from a strongly recommended position to a required position that can be co-held with another position in each Student Society within two years of the 2019 AOR meeting – **PASSED**

**2019-03:** The Student Academy resolves to increase PA student awareness of the concepts and technical skills of point-of-care ultrasound through currently available resources. – **PASSED**

**2019-04:** The Student Academy recommends identifying barriers to admission to PA school for prospective applicants of low socioeconomic status, minority students, and other traditionally underrepresented backgrounds and identify potential solutions. – **PASSED**

**2019-05:** The Student Academy resolves to create an awareness campaign that improves student awareness of Optimal Team Practice (OTP) educational materials. – **PASSED**

**2019-07:** The Student Academy recommends that the Student Board of Directors investigate ways of making the annual AAPA national conference more financially accessible for PA students. – **PASSED**

**2019-08:** The Student Academy and Service Committee recommends the implementation of a system to log student volunteer experiences, thus better quantifying the impact that students are making in the community. – **PASSED**
