## **Purpose**


- To determine the reach of PAs in federal employment, including where they are located, as well as select personal characteristics

## **Methods**


Four sources of data were used:

- **US Office of Personnel** Management (OPM) via FedScope data tool.
- Correspondence with relevant parties for military staffing
- **NCCPA**
- **Bureau of Labor Statistics**

Data years were September 1998 through 2018.

Civilian PAs were identified by their occupational civilian code: 0603.
