About the Program

AAPA and PAF recently launched PAthways, an initiative focused on fostering diversity within the PA profession. Backed by a grant from Pfizer, PAthways aims provide mentorship and shadowing opportunities for students and recent graduates of color interested in pursuing PA school.

Eligibility

Mentee applicants must be: 1) enrolled at or recent graduates of one our participating institutions; 2) planning to apply to PA school within 1-2 years; and (3) able to commit to 10-20 hours of mentorship activities.

We are looking for 5-10 pre-PA student mentees from each of the following schools:

- Howard University (Washington, DC)
- Fayetteville State University (Fayetteville, NC)
- Rutgers University-Newark (Newark, NJ)
- Baruch College (New York, NY)

Responsibilities

Selected mentees must be available for program activities during the 2024-2025 school year.

Activities will include:

- 10-20 hours of small-group and individual mentorship sessions
- 3 virtual meetings of the full program cohort
- Clinical shadowing opportunities (when possible)
